## What are Contributions and Charges?

At Atwell College, we strive to provide quality teaching and learning experiences that empower our students to thrive and be successful, both during their time at the College and beyond. The Australian Government provides funding to cover the cost of staff, facility maintenance and basic resources, with funding dependent on various factors such as student numbers, socio-economic factors of the area and student characteristics. At Atwell College we enrich the educational experience with funds collected through the Voluntary Contributions and Charges.

Funds collected from the Atwell College families are spent on a range of resources, including more specialised equipment and resources aimed at providing educational experiences that prepare students for the world beyond school. We ask that you invest \$235 per year (\$6 a week) to enhance your child's learning opportunities. When our College and community work together, our young people are the ones who benefit.

### What is the difference between 'Contributions' & 'Charges'?

Voluntary Contributions are non-compulsory payments that the College may request from parents/guardians. They help supplement the funding provided by the Government for the delivery of core subjects—Mathematics, English, Humanities and Social Sciences (HASS), and Science (MESH)—from Years 7 to 10, as well as Physical Education, The Arts, and Technologies in Years 7 and 8.

Your support enables the College to maintain up-to-date resources and equipment across these key learning areas. We encourage all families to contribute where possible to enhance the educational experience for all students.

Charges are <u>compulsory</u> for all elective subjects. From years 9 to 12, these elective subjects are offered by the College at its discretion and therefore are **not** covered by Government funding. All subject costs for Year 11 and 12 are compulsory charges; however, Atwell College's Board has directed our efforts towards keeping costs as low and as equitable as possible.

When choosing subjects for upper school during Year 10, the College will ask for a 50% deposit payment when upper school subjects are selected.

### Years 7 - 10

#### **Voluntary Contributions Years 7-10:**

The School is requesting a voluntary contribution of up to \$235.00 for each student towards the cost of materials, textbooks, services and facilities used by students in the educational program. The payment of these costs will make a significant contribution to the quality of educational programs delivered. There is an expectation that families who can afford to pay the Voluntary Contributions do so. Payment of these costs is voluntary but encouraged and appreciated.

#### **Voluntary Approved Requests:**

To assist in meeting the cost of other services offered to students, the school requests parents to contribute to the below Voluntary Approved Requests:

- **P&C Contribution (\$25.00)**: The Parents and Citizens Association deeply appreciates family contributions which are instrumental in enabling ongoing fundraising efforts. The P&C is dedicated to enhancing the facilities and learning environment for our students.
- Chaplaincy/Pastoral Care Fund (\$25.00): We invite a personal contribution of \$25.00 however additional donations over this amount are gratefully accepted. The school's Chaplain, crucial for providing full-time pastoral care, receives only limited funding from the Federal Government. Contributions help sustain this role, allowing all students to benefit from the Chaplain's programs irrespective of their personal beliefs. Participation in these programs is entirely optional for students and families. The Chaplain offers crucial support to students and their families, fostering encouragement, motivation and inspiration to help our youth achieve their fullest potential and navigate life's challenges. The generosity shown by families in supporting the Chaplain's work, which contributes significantly to the overall wellbeing of students, is highly valued.
- Information Technology Fund (\$15.00): This contribution assists with the procurement and renewal of IT resources available to all students. It serves as an essential aid in supporting your child's educational pursuits, ensuring they have access to cutting-edge technology. The Department of Education allocates a modest budget for the resources at this facility.
- **Library Contribution (\$25.00)**: A contribution is sought to assist the Library in obtaining materials for students, guaranteeing the availability of up-to-date resources to complement the modern curriculum.
- **Bus Fund (\$10.00)**: A designated contribution is being sought to facilitate the acquisition and operation of the college bus, which is utilized for various educational trips during the academic year.

While contributing to these voluntary approved requests is optional, your support through payment will be greatly appreciated and valued.

## **Payment Information and Assistance**

#### **Payment Options**

The College has the following payment options:

- **BPoint** is a quick and easy way to pay for Contributions and Charges online, simply follow the link sent to you via email from Compass or alternatively go to the payments section on the College Website www.atwellcollege.wa.edu.au/view/payments.
- **Direct Deposit:** Pay using your internet banking. It is very important that you enter your child's full name or student number as reference.

- Credit Card/Debit Card: Visa or MasterCard only. By completing the credit card information at the bottom of the Contributions & Charges Sheet and returning to the College. Payments can also be made at College Reception or by phoning 6174 2200.
- **Payment plans** are welcome and accounts must be finalized by the end of Term 3. Please contact administration to discuss.
- Please note the College has moved to CompassPay in Term 3 2024 and this is the preferred method of payment for Excursions and Camp and some events.
   We will also use Compasstix for events.

### **Secondary Assistance Scheme Allowance (SAS)**

The allowance consists of two components:

- Clothing Allowance (\$300) paid directly to the parent/carer or to the College to be allocated towards any charges and then contributions. These funds cannot be transferred to the uniform shop by the College.
- Education Program Allowance (EPA) Applications close 11 April 2025.
  The Western Australian Department of Education provides an allowance of \$235 to
  assist eligible families with secondary schooling costs. The EPA will be paid directly
  to the College and will be applied to compulsory charges for Years 7 12. For those
  parents or carers who elect to allocate their clothing allowance directly to the
  College, these funds will be deducted from the compulsory charges first and then
  any other contributions and/or charges. The allowances below are available to
  secondary students provided the eligibility criteria is met.



#### Eligibility Criteria

Parent or carer must hold one of the following cards:

- Centrelink Family Health Care Card
- Centrelink Pensioner Concession Card
- Veterans' Affairs Pensioner Concession Card (blue card only)

The parent or carer must be the holder of a card that is valid during Term 1. The only exception to this is when a student holds a healthcare card in their name and is declared an independent youth by the Department of Human Services (Centrelink) (e.g., living away from home). In this instance, a letter of confirmation from Centrelink needs to accompany the application. The allowance is paid up to and including the year the student turns 18 years of age. Applications are made by the parent or carer for students enrolled in Years 7 - 12. Application forms are to be completed at the College during term 1 and closes April 2025.







#### **Processing of Payments**

Completed forms will be forwarded electronically to the Schools Resourcing and Support Directorate for processing and the uniform money will be credited to parent/guardians' accounts (allow 5-10 working days).

#### Late Applications

Late applications will only be accepted under extenuating circumstances and must be accompanied with a written explanation or if the student has recently arrived from interstate or overseas and enrolled after the end of first term.

#### **Abstudy Supplement Allowance (ASA)**

The ABSTUDY Supplement Allowance is available to valid Department of Human Services(Centrelink) cardholders; this funding supplements the Department of Human Services (Centrelink) ABSTUDY Fees Allowance payment.

Applicants apply through the Department of Human Services (Centrelink) for the ABSTUDY Fees Allowance. A payment of \$79.00 is then made to the College directly by Centrelink. Furthermore, the College or parent/guardian must have received the School Fee Allowanceof \$78.00 or \$156.00 from the Department of Human Services (Centrelink) as part of the student's ABSTUDY School Fees Allowance.

Payment of the ABSTUDY Supplement Allowance is made directly to the College and will be applied to voluntary contributions for Years 7 - 10 and compulsory charges for Years 11 and 12.

Please take note that you cannot claim both the SAS and ASA.

The Saver Plus initiative is a national matched savings program that assists people to save for education expenses by matching their savings, dollar for dollar (up to \$500). Atwell College has a Bring Your Own Device (BYOD) Program where all students can bring

their own device(s) to the college and use them in digital lessons when required. The College has online portals with selected machines from vendors such as JB HI-FI, Winthrop and CDM where parents can go to and get amazing pricing on devices that have been selected and meet the minimum requirements for the digital focused lessons.

#### **SmartRider Identification Cards**

SmartRider Identification cards are ordered for all new students on their first day and arrive after photo day during Term 1. The cost of the initial card is free. All cards include a photo for identification purposes. Replacement cards can be issued from the college library at the cost of \$5.00 per card.

### **Important Information**

#### **Payment of Contributions & Charges**

For Year 7-10, charges for electives are required to be paid in full **by the end of Term 1**. For Years 11 and 12, all charges are compulsory. Charges will depend on the course chosen. Some specific courses will incur higher costs dependent on factors such as texts, subject specific resources, materials, excursions, certificates and work placements.

\*Courses with cost above \$100 will incur a 50% deposit prior to the course commencement.

Students involved in work placement must pay the associated fees <u>prior to commencement</u> of the work placement.

Note: \*We reserve the right to place students in lower cost options if charges are not paid.

#### **Compassionate View**

The College is only too aware that the payment of College contributions and charges can be a burden for some families. Payment plans are available to support parents/guardians experiencing difficulties. Ignoring accounts and reminders is unhelpful to all parties. The College is also keen to assist parents/guardians in selecting options that they can afford. To this end, subject charges will always be provided to parents/guardians prior to selection of subjects.

#### **Collection of Contributions & Charges**

The College will take a positive approach to collecting contributions from parents/guardians. In particular, the College will highlight the benefits to students if all parents/guardians meet their contributions. The College will actively seek full payment of charges.

- In 2025 a statement will be emailed during Term 1. In Term 2, the College will email a reminder notice to show any outstanding balances.
- Outstanding charges are rolled over to the student's record in the following year where applicable.
- Year 11 and 12 high-cost subjects will be subject to a 50% confirmation charge during subject selection

Where parents with outstanding compulsory charges have failed to arrange and commit to a payment plan, the student may be removed from their chosen elective courses and be placed in a lower cost option. In the case where the unpaid compulsory charges cover the cost of materials for the practical classes, the student may not be able to participate in the practical lessons and will have to complete only theory work.

#### **Excursion/Incursion Information**

Atwell College uses Compass for our incursion and excursion planning. All information is stored in accordance with the Australian privacy requirements. Parents/guardians will receive an email invitation when your child is scheduled to attend excursions. Parents/guardians are able to provide consent, make payment, amend contact details and medical and allergy information through Compass.

#### **Endorsed Programs**

An endorsed program is a significant learning program that has been developed for senior secondary students. The program may have been developed by the School Curriculum and Standards Authority, or it may have been developed by a private provider or a school and subsequently endorsed by the Authority.

Endorsed programs can be delivered as part of the school curriculum or as extracurricular activities. Enrolment in endorsed programs needs tobe negotiated with the VET office or Associate Principal and is approved on a case-by-casebasis.

#### Workplace Learning (ADWPL)

Students from Years 10 to 12 may wish to enrol in Workplace Learning (ADWPL) to gain credits towards their WACE. There are strict reporting requirements that must be met.

Students will be required to fully complete the College Logbook(s) and Skills Journal(s) along with completing mandatory workplace hours.

Atwell College students may participate in activities such **as paid or unpaid employment outside of school hours.** These programs often occur outside of school hours and are referred to as outside of school workplace arrangements. Atwell College students may also participate in **unpaid Workplace Learning during school hours** in some instances. This is often targeted BLOCK release, as part of a VET Qualification. An Expression of Interest form must be collected from the VET office, completed and approved prior to enrolment.

School Based Traineeship/Apprenticeship students will also be enrolled in ADWPL; this process needs to be negotiated with the VET office and is approved on a case-by-case basis.

At all times students must meet industry standards and this is the responsibility of students. This may require holding a current White Card, completing Drug and Alcohol testing, presenting proof of vaccination and/or providing appropriate PPE (Personal Protection Equipment).


